Year 11 pupils at Durham High School for Girls celebrate an outstanding set of GCSE results with 60% of entries at A and A*. **A third of the year group obtained at least 9 As and A*s.**

Mrs Templeman, Headmistress said “The girls have once again excelled themselves with these superb results; every pupil here takes at least one language at GCSE and some take three. Half of the year group took separate sciences at GCSE and intend to study science and/or maths at A Level”.
